Sewanee: The University of the South seeks a tenure-track Assistant Professor of Spanish beginning Fall 2012. Ph.D. in hand, native/near native fluency in Spanish, and ability to communicate successfully in colloquial English are essential, as is familiarity with the liberal arts curriculum. Area of specialization for the position is Latin America, with preference given to those with a specialty in 20th / 21st Century Central American Narrative.

Candidates must demonstrate ability to teach a wide variety of courses, most of them at the beginning and intermediate language level. Prior experience in service learning is also desirable.

The University of the South comprises a highly-regarded College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and a distinguished School of Theology. It is an institution of the Episcopal Church that welcomes individuals of all backgrounds. It is located on a striking, 13,000-acre campus on Tennessee's Cumberland Plateau.

Eligibility for employment is contingent upon successful completion of a background screening. Only applications received by the January 6, 2012 deadline will be considered for the position.
