<b>DEFINITIONS AND OTHER CONSEQUENCES</b>						
<sup>1</sup> Social Probation: loss of driving privileges, loss of gown, possible loss of activity privileges, another violation leads to suspension						
<sup>2</sup> Campus Privileges: loss of ability to participate in fraternity/sorority rush & must leave campus 24 hours after last exam for all remaining semesters						
* Possession of alcohol in a glass bottle increases fine by \$25						
** May also be referred to local authorities for adjudication						
Conduct Forgiveness: A one-time opportunity for a student to delete a Category 1 first offense from his/her record by providing 30 hours of community service within 6 weeks from the date of the offense						
Offenses are cumulative over a student's career at the institution
