



Director of Dining Services

The University of the South invites applications for the position of Director of Dining Services. Although a final decision has not been made, the University is considering the option to manage the food service operations internally rather than outsourcing the operations as it has done for many years. The current contractual food service agreement expires in the summer of 2012. The proposed Director of Dining Services will provide strategic direction and leadership for all on campus food service operations. The Director will lead and coordinate the development of departmental policies, procedures, goals and long-term plans, with the objective of establishing a motivated and cohesive team that will provide excellent dining services for students, faculty, staff, and guests of the University. Bachelor's degree in Food Service Management, Nutrition or related field required, with six to eight years of experience in management of large scale food service operations, preferably in higher education.

The University of the South is comprised of a well-regarded College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and a distinguished School of Theology. It is an institution of the Episcopal Church that welcomes individuals of all backgrounds. It is located on a striking, 13,000-acre campus on Tennessee's Cumberland Plateau.
