The Political Science Department at The University of the South seeks applications for a tenure-track position at the assistant professor level in the politics of Africa to begin August 2012.

The teaching load for this position is three courses per semester and typically includes five course preparations. The successful candidate will teach two sections of Introduction to World Politics, upper division courses in his or her areas of expertise, and, perhaps, Comparative Politics. The department is particularly interested in candidates who can offer courses on Sub-Saharan Africa, as well as courses on international organizations/global civil society, and post-colonial and post-conflict development. The capacity to offer a course on Middle Eastern politics will be viewed favorably.

The University of the South comprises a well-regarded College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and a distinguished School of Theology. It is an institution of the Episcopal Church that welcomes individuals of all backgrounds. It is located on a striking, 13,000-acre domain on Tennessee's Cumberland Plateau.
